## Microsoft Certification

Microsoft technical certification is an objective way to acknowledge your professional skills with Microsoft technology. The MCP exams have been developed over the years with the input of leading professionals in the IT industry.

The University of Greenwich is a registered Microsoft IT Academy and can offer training leading towards Microsoft Certified Professional (MCP), Microsoft Certified Systems Administrator (MCSA) and Microsoft Certified Systems Engineer (MCSE).

## Course Overview:

You will get hands-on experience of using the latest Microsoft software and use authorised Microsoft courseware.

The course will be delivered in the form of notes and practical lab sessions. Students will read through and learn the materials in their own time and will have the use of a lab for dedicated lab sessions one evening a week for three hours, 6pm to 9pm. This session will be used for the practical lab sessions and for discussing problems or subjects with the Instructor.

The tutorials are run using the Virtual PC environment. The virtual hard disks contain the operating system on which you are able to perform all tasks necessary for the course without changing the configuration of a physical machine. Students will also be able to use the computing facilities on campus outside of class hours.

Certification exams must be taken up to a 6 months after the course at a Registered Microsoft Certification Testing Centre. The price of exam is INCLUDED in the price of the course.

## MCSA – MS Windows Server 2003 Track

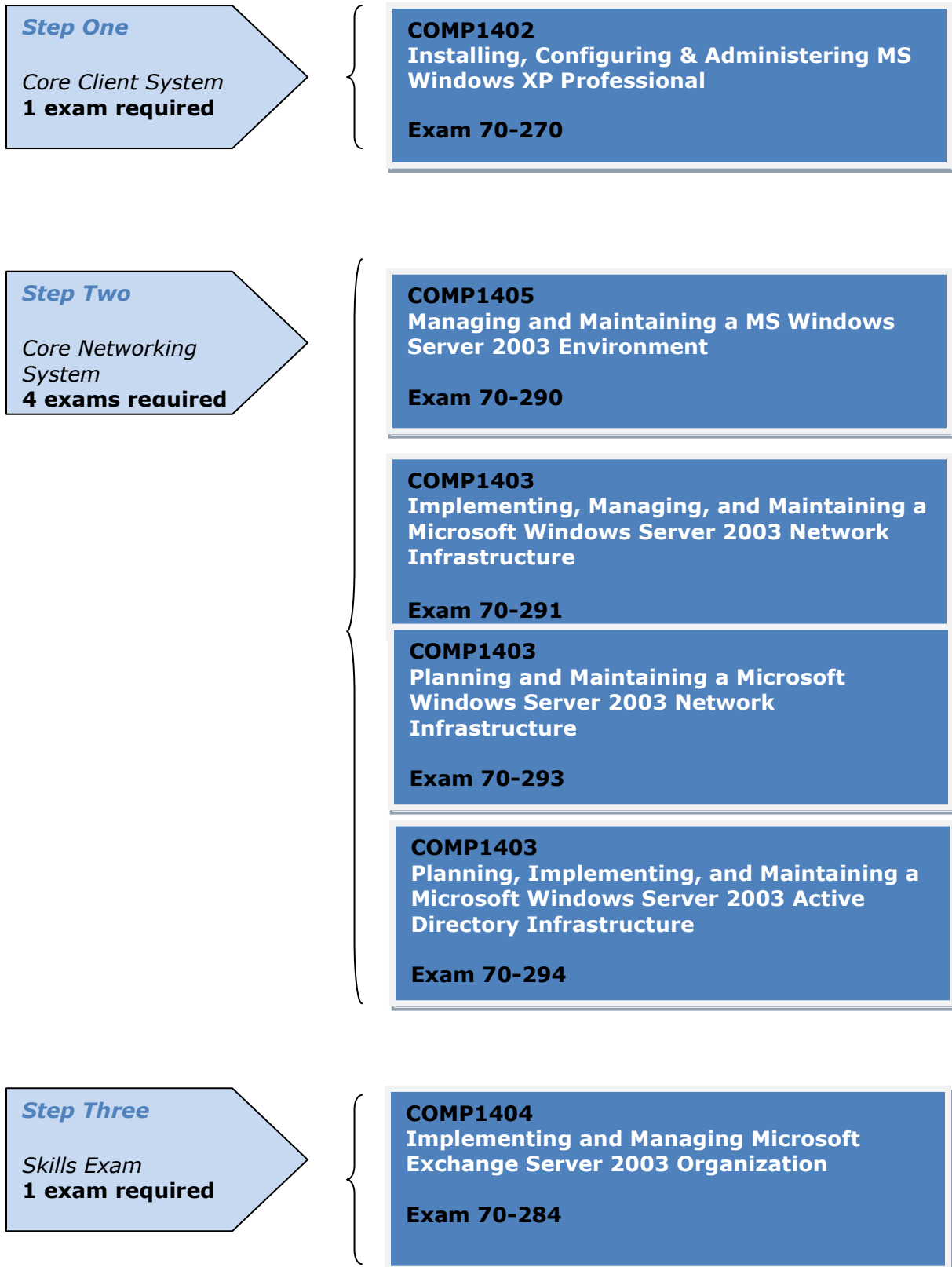
Microsoft Certified Systems Administrator
